Twelve-year-old Meghan has never made it through the night at a sleepover, but sheâ <sup>™</sup>s determined to make it through this one. Her two besties, Anna-Marie and Paige,

promise it will be EPIC!It turns out to be a little too epic. The girls wake up to a disaster of a basement and no recollection of what happened the night before. One of Meghanâ <sup>™</sup>s eyebrows is missingâ |and so is Anna-Maria! The girls need to straighten out the hijinks of the night before, all the while collecting clues about what happened to their missing friend, and they have only a couple hours until the parents show up for pick-up.
