

This book does have a couple of inaccuracies, but for the majority of the book it is very accurate. This book has given me the oppurtunity to create a unit for the local school districts that I work with in providing an accurate account of our history and the real struggle to survive. I was able to include the leaders at that time and their role in the removals on both sides with the Ho-Chunk leaders, and the American officials. I would reccomend this to any teacher that is looking to include Native History with in their classrooms that has factual information.
