

This short book covers many of the basic facts about our solar system, and briefly touches on the universe as a whole. Honestly, I wasn't really happy with this book until about the 10th page. The title of the book is a little misleading, until about half way through. By the end of the book, I was impressed with the information it contained. However, I can't overlook that most (if not all) of the images are renderings only, and the only labeled overview of the solar system (on page 4) leaves out Mars and Uranus, but includes Pluto. No where does it say that these are the planets, but it certainly looks like a larger image cropped to fit, but in a negative way that leaves out information. The last half of the book is the part which really redeems it for me. Even though the planets are all depicted as crude multicolored spheres, the information contained within the text is condensed and appropriate for young astronomers. What really impressed me is that I even learned something in the dwarf planet pages. Ceres and Eris were considered "planet"s, before that word was officially defined in 2006.As a result, I would definitely recommend this book for young astronomers.
