


The Magic Of Friendship

He will teach Hasmukh to be scary if Hasmukh will teach him how to be funny. The two spend a lot of time together trying to teach each other how to be scary and funny. In the end Hasmukh never becomes scary and Babbar never becomes funny, but they do become great friends. The other animals of the forest also realize that they no longer have to fear Babbar and they can all play together. My girls really enjoyed this book and recognized that while it may be scary at first to reach out to somone new, they may turn out to be a great friend.

This is a really cute story about a ferocious lion who always gets his way, but is never happy and doesnâ [™]t know how to laugh. The there is a donkey who is very funny, but also scared all the time. Can either of them learn to go against their nature?
